VILLAGE TAKES COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE “ON THE ROAD”

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One of the key priorities in Paul Wm. Hoefert’s successful campaign for Mayor was to find new ways to engage the residents and businesses of Mount Prospect. As a result, Mount Prospect’s Village Board is taking their next Committee of the Whole meeting “on the road.”

Committee of the Whole [COW] meetings are an opportunity for staff and scheduled presenters to provide information to the Village Board on specific topics of interest, while also allowing for feedback from the public on these issues. No formal action is taken at a COW, as the focus is on open discussion and recommendations for next steps.

The COW On The Road event will take place at RecPlex, 420 Dempster Street, on Tuesday, June 14th from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. This location was specifically chosen as the agenda will focus on issues directly related to south Mount Prospect.

In addition to the Village Board of Trustees, key members of the Village Leadership Team will be in attendance to answer questions from attendees and to provide an overview of all that’s happening in south Mount Prospect. The discussions may include: the recently adopted South Mount Prospect TIF district, new development occurring on the south side of the Village including the Mount Prospect Technology Campus, implementation of the Village’s Connect South Mount Prospect sub-area plan, infrastructure improvements such as the Algonquin shared use path and potential water main extension. For residents living in the area who are not incorporated into the Village, we will also have the opportunity to discuss the status of the Rural Fire District and the Village’s plan to ensure fire and emergency medical services continue to be provided in the years to come.

“This will be a great time to come out to a world-class recreation facility owned and operated by the Mt. Prospect Park District and meet your Village Board of Trustees,” said Mayor Hoefert. “The meeting will be informal to allow residents the opportunity to ask questions and hear about some of the exciting things happening in South Mount Prospect.”
