Village of Mount Prospect Responds to Weather Emergency

Mount Prospect, IL – Shortly after 4:45 pm, the Mount Prospect Fire Department was dispatched to a four-story apartment complex at 701 Huntington Commons Road with reports of the complex's roof partially torn off.

Emergency responders evacuated the building immediately and reported no injuries. The building that holds over 60 units has been deemed uninhabitable for the night. Human Services and the American Red Cross are working together to meet the needs of the displaced residents. At this time, donations from the community are not needed.

The Mt. Prospect Park District RecPlex (420 Dempster St.) is serving as the meetup point for those who are displaced. Human Services and the American Red Cross will be on site overnight to intake the affected tenants.

Mount Prospect residents may report power outages to ComEd, who are currently on scene. Those affected by power outages who are left without air conditioning are encouraged to visit cooling centers at the Mount Prospect Police Headquarters (911 Kensington Rd.) or the Mt. Prospect Park District RecPlex.

It is believed that this damage was the result of a microburst. The Village of Mount Prospect will share updates as needed.

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
