

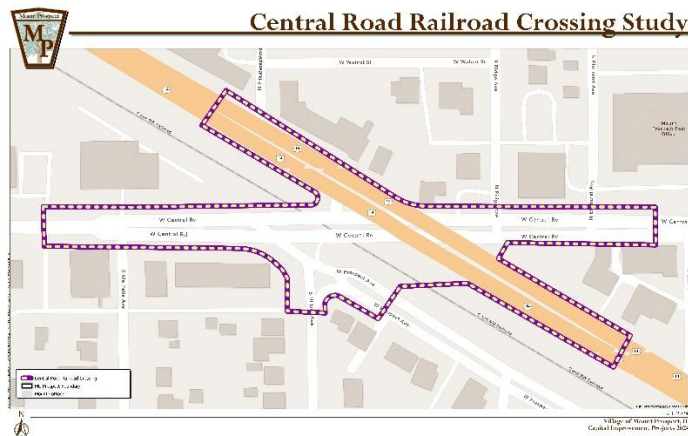

Village of Mount Prospect to Host Public Information Meeting on Central Road Railroad Crossing Phase I Study

Mount Prospect, IL – The Village of Mount Prospect will hold a Public Information Meeting on Thursday, June 5, concerning the Central Road Railroad Crossing Phase I Study. The study aims to address safety concerns and improve mobility for all users at the Central Road Railroad Crossing and the intersection of Central Road with Northwest Highway (US-14).



The purpose of the meeting is to present the goals and need for the project; designs to address the project needs; the project schedule; and traffic data. The public will have an opportunity to ask questions and provide input to help determine a preferred alternative.

The meeting will be held from 5 - 7 pm in the Farley Community Room on the first floor of Village Hall, 50 S. Emerson St. It will be conducted in an open-house format with project displays and other information available for viewing. Village staff will be available to provide additional details and answer questions.
