NSMJAWA Successfully Completes Water Main Repair

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The Village of Mount Prospect is pleased to announce that the Northwest Suburban Joint Action Water Agency (NSMJAWA) successfully completed repairs to its 90-inch transmission water main on **Friday, April 4, 2025, at 9:00 PM**. The repair work began on **Tuesday, April 1, 2025, at 7:00 AM**.

The leak, located on the south side of the I-90 tollway just east of the Elmhurst Road overpass, was repaired without any impact to water quality or service for Mount Prospect customers. During the repair period, the Village utilized its newly constructed emergency water interconnect with the Northwest Water Commission to maintain a continuous supply of Lake Michigan water.

This successful repair followed a previous attempt on March 24 that did not resolve the issue. NSMJAWA coordinated with its member communities to ensure service continuity and communicated regularly throughout the repair process.

As a reminder, Mount Prospect residents and businesses served by Illinois American Water (IAW) were not affected by this repair.

The Village thanks residents for their cooperation and extends appreciation to the Northwest Water Commission, NSMJAWA, and all involved partners for their swift and effective response to this issue.
