Mount Prospect Police Department Investigating Fatal Traffic Crash Involving A Motorcycle

On Saturday, June 20, 2026, at approximately 10:01 PM, a Mount Prospect Police Officer came upon a serious traffic crash involving a vehicle and a motorcycle on Rand Road (Route 12) near Henry Street. The officer located the motorcycle driver southeast of the intersection with serious injuries. The motorcycle driver, later identified as Scotty J. Stuck, 20 years old, of Des Plaines, was transported to Advocate Lutheran General Hospital in Park Ridge by the Mount Prospect Fire Department, where he was pronounced deceased.

The preliminary investigation revealed Stuck was traveling on a motorcycle southeast bound on Rand Road approaching Henry Street when his motorcycle collided with a Subaru SUV on Rand Road. The Subaru was being driven by a 33-year-old male of Mount Prospect, who was not injured as a result of the crash.

This fatal traffic crash is currently being investigated by the Mount Prospect Police Department Major Crash Investigation Team, along with the assistance from the Major Case Assistance Team's Serious Traffic Accident Reconstruction (STAR) Team. Rand Road was closed between the private driveway for the Texas Roadhouse restaurant and Central Road and reopened at approximately 6:22 AM. The investigation into the cause of the crash is still ongoing and more information will be provided when it is available.
