The Mount Prospect Village Board is holding its June 9 Committee of the Whole (COW) meeting on the road at Burning Bush Community Center, 1313 N. Burning Bush Ln. at 6 pm. Agenda topics include an update on the MP2040 Comprehensive Plan, a review of sidewalk and street lighting programs, and hearing from north side residents.
