Briefing Schedule and Trial Schedule Order

Before the court is Prestige Feed Products, LLC's ("**Prestige**") 1) Combined § 2-619 Motion For Judgment On The Pleadings And Partial Summary Judgment On The Village's Third Amended Counterclaim ("**Village Motion**") against the Village of Mount Prospect ("**Village**") and 2) Combined § 2-619.1 Motion To Dismiss The Verified Complaint Of Intervenor City Of Des Plaines ("**City Motion**") against the City of Des Plaines ("**City**") The motions having been tendered to the court, and the court finding that a briefing schedule is warranted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Regarding Prestige's Village Motion, the Village is given leave to file a brief in excess of the page limit and shall file any response to the Village Motion *Instantly*, with a copy thereof to be immediately served upon all parties entitled to notice pursuant to rule. Regarding Prestige's City Motion, the City shall file any response to the City motion by December 13, 2024, with a copy thereof to be immediately served upon all parties entitled to notice pursuant to rule.
2. Prestige shall file any reply to both the Village Motion and the City Motion on or before January 10, 2025, with a copy thereof to be immediately served upon all parties entitled to notice pursuant to rule. Prestige has leave to file a reply brief in excess of the page limit related to the Village Motion.

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- Opening briefs and response briefs cannot exceed 15 pages. Reply briefs cannot exceed 7 pages. Briefs must contain customary 12-point font, one-inch margins, page numbers, and be double-spaced. No condensed fonts. Briefs filed in excess of these limitations will not be accepted without prior leave of Court upon written motion containing good cause.

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- No supplemental briefs or citations filed without prior leave of court.
- No continuances of any kind of the above dates will be granted without prior leave of court.

3. Movant shall deliver to law.calwcc@cookcountyil.gov by electronic means (e.g., email attachment, cloud-based storage, or USB thumb drive): (1) a copy of this order, (2) text-searchable PDF copies of all the briefs with bookmarks and exhibits, (3) the most recent copies of all pleadings (complaint, answer, counterclaim, defenses, etc.), and (4) any other relevant documents that have been filed with the court, by the Clerk Status date on January 14, 2025, at 8:45 AM. No in person appearance is necessary. The electronic delivery shall be accompanied by a cover letter or cover email containing the case number, caption, and a statement that the delivery is pursuant to this order. The movant shall copy all parties of record to this correspondence.

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4. Courtesy copies of all documents shall be delivered to the court electronically (e.g., email attachment, cloud-based storage, or USB thumb drive) in an organized and searchable format with exhibits properly attached and marked. Any electronic files submitted to the court shall state in the filename (1) the date the document was filed in the form YYYY-MM-DD; and (2) identification of what the document is. By way of example, the filenames may appear in the following form:

If there are multiple motions, they shall be contained within a separate folder for each respective motion along with that motion's response and reply. Each folder and its contents shall be saved within a .zip file.

5. Additionally, a complete set of hard copies of all documents shall be dropped off in the bin located outside courtroom 1912 no later than 3:00 PM on the Clerk Status date.

6. Upon the court's timely receipt of all the courtesy copies, the Court will hold oral argument on January 28, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in person in Courtroom 1912.

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7. The Court sets the following discovery and trial deadlines:





- A. Written discovery to be completed by January 31, 2025.
- B. Non-expert oral discovery to be completed by May 30, 2025.
- C. Expert disclosures to be made by June 13, 2025.
- D. Expert oral discovery to be completed by July 11, 2025.
- E. Dispositive motions to be filed by July 25, 2025.
- F. Final pre-trial status set for September 18, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. IN PERSON.
- G. Trial, in person, is set for a two week period beginning on September 22, 2025 at 10:30 AM and continuing the week thereafter on September 29, 2025.
