Information

The Village has received over 1,200 citizen complaints of foul odors, nuisances, and general smell complaints that surround the Kensington Business Park and more specifically the business at 431 Lakeview Court, Prestige Feed, over the last five years. Many residents have expressed concerns related to the potential impacts of the odor and pollution being discharged by Prestige.

In response to citizen complaints, the Village has been in the process of finding and securing a scientifically focused research group that can study the area, understand the specific needs of the Village, and test for any materials hazardous to citizen health. Research into testing organizations has led the Village to the RHP organization RHP. RHP scientists use a scientifically rigorous regulatory frameworks in toxicology, exposure modeling, etc., to assess risk profiles of chemicals. RHP will provide both air sampling and emission dispersion modeling from multiple data points to assist the Village in the on-going litigation with Prestige Feed. The cost is a fixed fee of \$69,000.
