Dear all,

Thank you for your detailed feedback.

The most sensical solution is to reach a consensus between our clients and the Village regarding Prestige's operating hours.

Prestige suggested to all parties a regular operating schedule of 3 weeknights and 3 mornings for 28.5 hours a week. The chart below breaks this down. All machinery turns OFF before 5:30 AM. The Village will not impede Prestige from proceeding with this schedule if Mizkan has no objections.

Prestige operated through 5:30 am on the morning of Monday, April 5. When Mizkan's facility re-opened later that morning, no complaints arose. The next step involves Prestige operating in the morning hours of the earliest weekday with Mizkan not making any special adjustments to its HVAC system the night before.

Prestige requests to operate the above hours this Friday, Saturday and Sunday night through Monday morning (April 9 @ 8 pm through – April 12 @ 5:30 am). Mizkan will not make any out-of-

ordinary adjustments to its HVAC system. On Monday, April 12, 2021, we will consult and in good faith outline the next steps.

As Prestige understands the issue, Mizkan's operations may be affected when large amounts of fresh air are pushed into the HVAC system of the auxiliary building to clear out the steam created from the ovens of its food testing laboratory. This does not happen every day, and when it does, it occurs only within 8:30 am and 5:30 pm.

Prestige's operation listed above would start 2.5 hours after Mizkan's auxiliary facility closes and would stop 3 hours before Mizkan's facility reopens. These nightly hours overlap with the expected automatic set up by Mizkan's building engineer to reduce any air intake to any indoor facilities.

Please advise at the earliest convenience.
