## SERGEANT JACK BROGAN OF THE MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE DEPARTMENT GRADUATES FROM NORTHWESTERN UNIVERSITY'S CENTER FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

The Mount Prospect Police Department is pleased to announce the graduation of Sergeant Jack Brogan from the School of Police Staff and Command (SPSC) at Northwestern University's Center for Public Safety. Sergeant Brogan successfully completed the ten (10) week Staff and Command Program held in Evanston, Illinois from September 24 – December 7, 2018. This program, which was implemented by the Center for Public Safety in 1983, has graduated over 18,000 students both nationally and internationally. Sergeant Brogan was a student in SPSC Class #448, which accommodated 29 students for the ten-week period.

The School of Police Staff and Command provides upper-level college instruction in a total of twenty-seven core or mandatory blocks of instruction and additional optional blocks of instruction during each session. The major topics of study include Leadership, Human Resources, Employee Relations, Organizational Behavior, Applied Statistics, Planning and Policy Development, Budgeting and Resource Allocation.

Sergeant Brogan, along with his class colleagues, raised over \$10,000 as a legacy gift for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.
