PRESS RELEASE Mount Prospect Police Department Investigating Fatal Traffic Crash

On Sunday, March 7, 2021 at approximately 7:44 AM, the Mount Prospect Police Department responded to the report of a rollover traffic crash with entrapment on Rand Road (Route 12) and Mt. Prospect Road involving two vehicles.

Upon arrival, officers located a traffic crash on Rand Road, northwest of the intersection with Mt. Prospect Road, involving a white colored Honda sedan with heavy damage and a gold colored Ford SUV, which had heavy front end damage and rolled over onto the roof of the vehicle. Officers arrived and found the three occupants of the Honda were deceased. The preliminary investigation revealed the white Honda was travelling southbound from the exit of Mt. Prospect Plaza when the gold Ford, which was travelling northwest bound Rand Road from Central Road, entered the intersection and struck the sedan. The impact of the crash resulted in the gold Ford rolling over and coming to rest on its roof. The driver of the gold Ford was transported to local hospital after being extricated from the vehicle by the Mount Prospect Fire Department. The identities of the deceased are being withheld at this time while next of kin is notified.

This traffic crash is currently being investigated by the Mount Prospect Police Department Major Crash Investigation Team, along with the assistance from the Major Case Assistance Team's Serious Traffic Accident Reconstruction (STAR) Team. All lanes of Rand Road (Route 12) were opened at 5:00 PM. The investigation into the cause of the crash is still ongoing and more information will be provided when it is available.
