The Village of Mount Prospect will hold “An Evening of Remembrance” on Wednesday, March 24th at 7:00 p.m. Residents are invited to gather with the Interfaith Council at Village Hall, 50 S. Emerson Street, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Village Hall Board Room to honor and celebrate those who have been lost during the COVID-19 pandemic through a collective act of remembrance. Limited seating will be available. Registration is required by calling the Human Services Department at (847) 870-5680. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, a limit of two persons per household may attend. Masks are required. Only registered residents will be admitted. No walk-ins will be permitted.

Residents will be able to participate at home by live streaming the event here <http://bit.ly/mpremembrance>, or by tuning in through the Village’s Cable TV Channel 17 at the scheduled date and time of the event (available only for Comcast and WOW cable services).

As part of the event, the Village is inviting all businesses, government offices and residents to turn off their lights from 7:30pm - 7:33 p.m. on March 24 and place a lit candle of remembrance in a window.
