

# OVERHEAD SEWER REBATE PROGRAM

## OVERVIEW

The Village of Mount Prospect has established the Overhead Sewer Rebate Program. The program will provide financial assistance to residents who want to convert their existing gravity-fed sanitary system into an overhead sanitary sewer system (see exhibit on back). Note: This program does not cover an alternate flood control system or solutions for overland stormwater flooding.

To take advantage of the program, homeowners will need to:

- **Apply for the program (Pre-Approval Required)**
- Apply and obtain permits
- Obtain all required Village inspections during construction
- Apply for the Rebate Request after final inspection

To be eligible for the program:

- The homeowner must be a Village water utility consumer.
- The perimeter drain tile and any other stormwater source must be disconnected from the Village's sanitary or combined sewer.
- Installation of a sump pit and sump pump is required.
- The sump pump is to discharge the stormwater onto the ground in the property's front or rear. This requirement is not applicable if a proper sump pit for perimeter drain tile already exists.

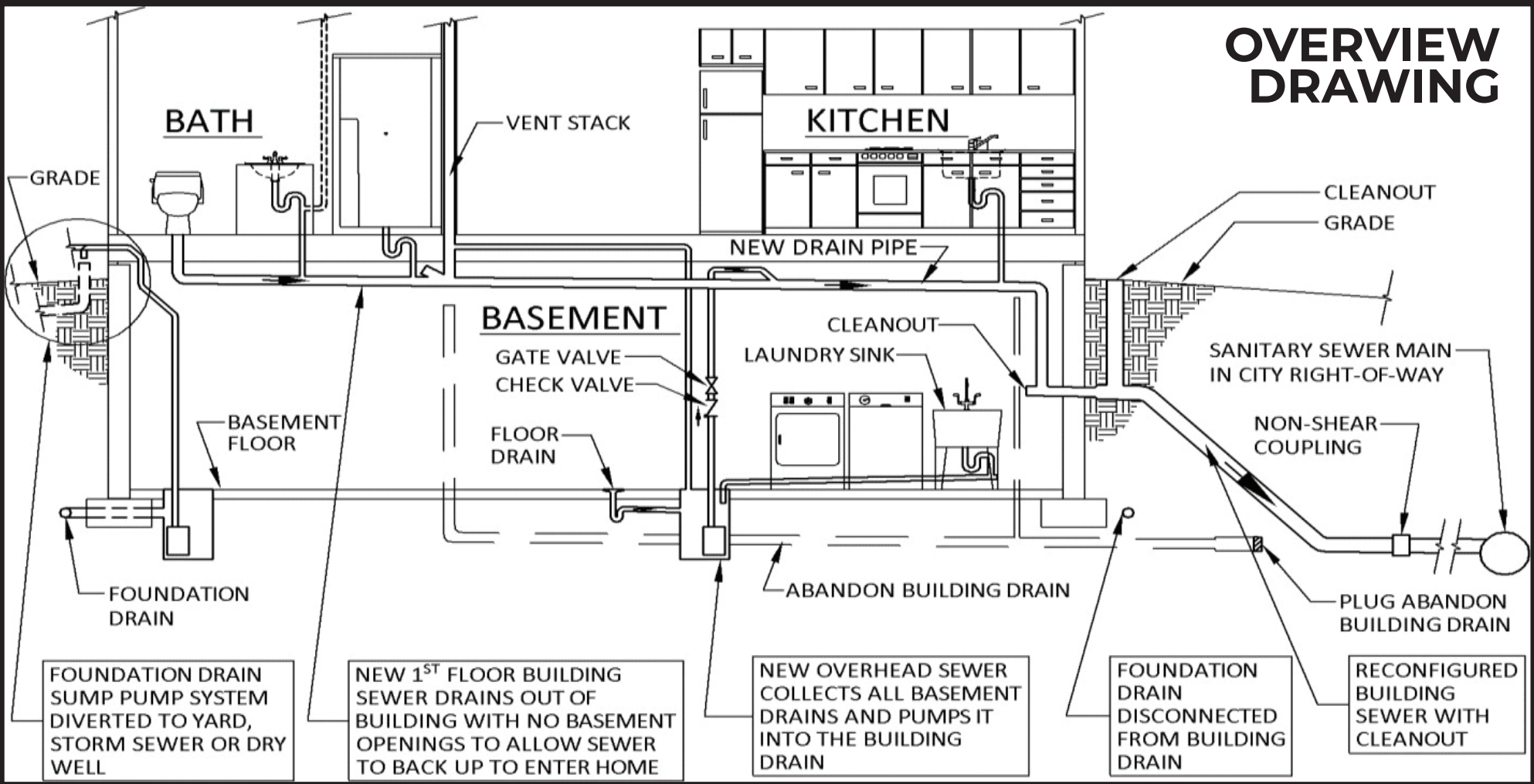
