Mount Prospect Police Arrest Person for Home Invasion and Aggravated Battery

On January 20, 2022, the Mount Prospect Police Department arrested and charged Zenovii Bliusovych, 30 years old, of 1 Renaissance Place, Palatine, Illinois with two counts of Home Invasion and one count of Aggravated Battery. These charges stem from an incident that occurred on November 13, 2021 in the 1500 block of North River West Court. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office approved charges against Bliusovych of two (2) felony counts of Home Invasion and one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery.

On November 13, 2021, at approximately 1:41 AM the Mount Prospect Police Department responded to an apartment in the 1500 block of North River West Court for a 911 call of a possible home invasion. Prior to police arrival, the offender left the apartment in an unknown direction. Officers learned from the victim that he was in his apartment when an unknown male, who appeared intoxicated, entered his unlocked apartment door and refused to leave. The offender began attacking the victim and attempted to strangle him. The victim was able to yell for help to his girlfriend in the other room of the apartment, who called 911. The victim's girlfriend

was able to help get the unknown offender off of the victim. The offender then fled from the apartment. Mount Prospect Police Detectives were able to identify Zenovii Bliusovych as the offender in the home invasion, locate him and then take him into custody.

Bliusovych was formerly charged on January 20, 2022. Bliusovych was taken to a bond hearing on January 21, 2022, where his bond was set at \$35,000.00. His next scheduled court date is set for February 4, 2022 at 9:00 AM in room 108 of the 3rd District Cook County Courthouse in Rolling Meadows.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
