#### **MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE COMMANDER GRADUATES FROM SENIOR MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE FOR POLICE AT BOSTON UNIVERSITY**

On Thursday, June 23, 2022, Mount Prospect Police Commander Anthony Addante graduated from the Senior Management Institute for Police (SMIP) Program at Boston University in Boston, Massachusetts. SMIP is a program of the Police Executive Research Forum that provides senior police executives with intensive training in the latest management concepts and practices used in business and government. It also features discussions of the most challenging issues facing law enforcement executives today.

A demanding three-week course, SMIP brings together a faculty from top universities, successful law enforcement chief executives, and subject matter experts from the private sector. It is designed for mid- to upper-level police executives who ultimately will lead police agencies throughout the United States and other participating countries. SMIP's curriculum addresses the issues that demand the attention of today's forward-thinking law enforcement

leaders. Classes normally are held at the Boston University School of Law, where participants learn and reside in the university's modern classrooms and residence hall.

Commander Addante is a 23-year veteran of the agency who has served as field youth officer, community oriented policing officer, field training officer coordinator, peer jury coordinator, and coordinator for the department's ILEAP accreditation. Addante was promoted to sergeant in 2010 and promoted to Commander in 2018 and currently oversees the department's Investigative Section.
