The Village of Mount Prospect Human Services Department, in collaboration with the Mount Prospect Fire Department, is offering holiday meal baskets and toys this holiday season to Mount Prospect families that meet financial eligibility criteria.

- Photo ID of self and all adults in the home, Children's birth certificates
- Proof of address
- Eligibility Criteria Proof of current SNAP benefits or income below 200% federal poverty limit
