New Veteran Banner Recognition Program

The Village of Mount Prospect is proud to recognize and pay tribute to Mount Prospect's military heroes for their sacrifice and service through a new Veteran Banner Recognition Program. The program honors current and former Mount Prospect residents who served in a branch of the United States military.

"The Veteran Banner Program is beautiful way for our community to recognize and remind us all of the Mount Prospect residents who served and sacrificed for our country," said Village Trustee John Matuszak.

By filling out a Veteran Banner application, and submitting a high resolution digital photo of the veteran in his/her uniform, the Village will create a banner to be displayed on Northwest Hwy, to honor a Mount Prospect veteran.

Veteran banners will be displayed prior to Memorial Day and Veterans Day for a period of at least one year before being retired. Due to a limited number of banner locations, applications are on a first-come, first-served basis, and the chosen applicants will be notified by the Village. There is no cost to participate in the program or have the banner created.
