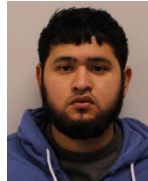

Second Man Charged with Attempted Murder

On February 09, 2023, Mount Prospect Police Detectives arrested and charged Bryan Estrada, 24 years old, of 327 Christine Lane, Hainesville, with one count of Attempted Murder. This charge stems from the investigation into a gang-related shooting involving a juvenile victim in the area of Aspen Drive and Aztec Lane on October 18, 2022. Estrada is the second offender charged with attempted murder, as a result of the investigation.

Mount Prospect Detectives were able to link physical and digital evidence from the scene of the shooting to Estrada.

On Tuesday, October 18, 2022 at approximately 8:28 PM, Mount Prospect Police Officers responded to the 1900 block of Seneca Lane for a report of shots fired and a person suffering from a gunshot wound. Officers located a juvenile victim with a single gunshot wound and immediately rendered aid to the victim. The Mount Prospect Fire Department responded and transported the juvenile victim to a local hospital. During the preliminary investigation, officers learned the victim and four friends were walking in the area of Aspen Drive and Aztec Lane when they were approached by three subjects on foot. Gang related comments were yelled, followed by shots being fired at the victim and his four friends. The victim fled eastbound on

foot and the offender(s) ran back to a nearby parked vehicle and fled the area. None of the victims lived in Mount Prospect. Mount Prospect Police Officers were able to locate multiple shell casings near the intersection of Aspen Drive and Aztec Lane.

Estrada appeared in bond court on February 10, 2023, where he was given a \$250,000 "D" bond. His next scheduled court date is March 3, 2023 at 9:00 AM in room 108 of the 3rd District Cook County Courthouse in Rolling Meadows.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
