Korean BBQ restaurant Mr. Kimchi opened a new Mount Prospect location in Randhurst Village, 164 Randhurst Village Dr. A ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremony is taking place on Monday, May 1, at 3:00 PM. Mr. Kimchi is open from 11:00 AM to midnight six days a week, closed on Tuesdays. In this new location, Mr. Kimchi is now the largest Korean BBQ restaurant in the Midwest.

Mr. Kimchi serves upscale Korean BBQ with the choice of 30 different proteins, traditional Korean sides, and an all you can eat option. To add to the ambience, diners get to utilize new, state-of-the-art table grills to cook their own food, with assistance from their servers. Additionally, the restaurant offers a full bar with everything from Japanese whiskey to 19 different flavors of soju, a popular Korean liquor. For guests who are just stopping in, Mr. Kimchi also serves nitro coffee, cold brew, and smoothies, all of which can be enjoyed inside or outside on their large patio/outdoor seating area.

"I'm so excited to be in Randhurst Village," said Taikyo Park, owner. Park noted that with the extensive parking and close proximity to entertainment and other restaurants, he hopes to bring more activity to the area.

After opening at the Golf Road location in 2017, Mr. Kimchi is Park's 18th restaurant. He attributes his love of the restaurant life to his mother and grandmother, who were both cooks, and is proud to carry on the family tradition here in Mount Prospect. "The people of Mount Prospect are so warm," stated Park. "They also love good food and are not shy about trying something new."
