Mount Prospect Village Board to Host Committee of the Whole Meeting "On the Road"

The Mount Prospect Village Board is taking its June 13 Committee of the Whole (COW) meeting "On the Road." This COW On the Road will be hosted at the Mt. Prospect Park District's Lions Recreation Center, 411 S. Maple St., from 6 to 8 PM.

At this meeting, Village staff will be presenting an update on downtown Mount Prospect. Topics will include but are not limited to the following:

- The significant amount of value generated by the Prospect and Main TIF District.
- Upcoming projects in the pipeline, including Dahlia Tequila Bar and Restaurant, Patina Wine Bar, The Prospect Restaurant, the Mia's Cantina expansion, and a new vein clinic.
- Downtown projects and initiatives, including the Busse Pocket Park and use of commuter lots for the Bluesmobile Cruise Nights and Farmers Market.
- Downtown infrastructure investments, including a proposed bike path, parking improvements, intersection signalization and crosswalk improvements, water main improvements, and a planned train platform extension.

About COWs On the Road

Taking a COW "On the Road" allows the Village Board to highlight a different location, business, or area in Mount Prospect while also giving residents a chance to attend a meeting closer to home. Established by Mayor Paul Wm. Hoefert, the Village Board plans to hold a COW On the Road quarterly.

"My goal is to bring government to the people," said Mayor Hoefert. "I understand that residents and the business community cannot always attend our meetings at Village Hall, so I want to make the process more accessible by meeting people where they are."
