The Mount Prospect Citizens Civics Academy will begin on September 6th and run for 8 consecutive weeks. The Academy is a series of free educational sessions designed to teach Mount Prospect residents about the inner workings of their local government. Space is limited, so residents are encouraged to apply by September 1. There is no cost for the class.

Civics Academy participants will learn about the many responsibilities and functions of the Village, the relationships between Village Departments and the community, and how services are provided. The Academy's goal is to educate the public and increase awareness about what their local government does for them, provide an inside look into government operations, and develop a better understanding of their role in Village government.
