Mount Prospect Police Department Promotes Two Veteran Officers

On Tuesday, August 15, 2023, the Mount Prospect Police Department promoted two veteran officers from within the department at the Mount Prospect Village Board meeting. Commander Anthony Addante was promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief of Administration and Officer Jeffrey Taylor was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and has joined the afternoon patrol shift.

Deputy Chief Addante is a 24 year veteran of the Mount Prospect Police Department. While with the department, Deputy Chief Addante has served as a Patrol Officer, Community Oriented Policing Officer, Patrol Sergeant, Sergeant of the Special Investigations and Gang Intelligence Unit, Administrative Sergeant, Patrol Commander, and most recently assigned as the Investigative Commander.
