The Mount Prospect Village Board is taking its November 14 Committee of the Whole (COW) meeting “On the Road.” This COW On the Road will be hosted at Holmes Junior High, 1900 Lonquist Blvd., from 6 to 8 PM.

The meeting will be a “town hall” where community members can bring any questions, concerns, and comments they have for the Village Board.

“One of my favorite parts of being the Mayor of Mount Prospect is interacting with the public and hearing from my fellow community members,” said Mayor Paul Wm. Hoefert. “I also believe in making local government more accessible, so I strongly encourage anyone who has comments or questions to come and share their thoughts with us.”

Taking a COW “On the Road” allows the Village Board to highlight a different location, business, or area in Mount Prospect while also giving residents a chance to attend a meeting closer to home. Established by Mayor Paul Wm. Hoefert, COWs on the Road are intended to bring government to the people. The Village Board plans to hold a COW On the Road quarterly.
