

INTRODUCTION

The Village of Mount Prospect is partnering with two regional water suppliers, Northwest Water Commission (NWC) and Northwest Suburban Municipal Joint Action Water Agency (NSMJAWA), to construct an emergency interconnection that will reduce the Village's reliance on its backup groundwater wells. The Village awarded the contract to Airy's, Inc, an underground General Contractor. A new water main will be installed along Elmhurst Avenue between Kensington Road and Highland Avenue. Additional work will take place at the Village's Pump Station No. 5 site located at Highland Street and Emerson Street (see attached map). The Contractor plans to mobilize in mid to late March. Street paving and parkway restoration will be performed after the pipe has been installed, pressure tested and disinfected. Temporary road closures will be necessary.

WHAT KIND OF WORK WILL BE DONE?

In general, the process of installing the new water main will include:

- Saw cutting of road.
- Open-cut trenching of the road
- Installation of the new water main
- Pressure testing and chlorination of the new water main
- Pavement restoration
- Parkway restoration

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF THE WORK

Estimated Start Date – March 18, 2024.

Estimated Completion Date – August 31, 2024.

WILL SERVICES TO MY PROPERTY BE AFFECTED?

Regular services such as garbage pick-up, mail delivery, or emergency services from the Police or Fire Departments are expected to continue during Construction. However, there may be times when construction activities temporarily restrict access to your property as the new water main is installed. We will try to make accommodations to keep these interruptions as short as possible. If a new curb or sidewalk is to be installed in front of your property, access to your driveway will be interrupted for an extended period. In that case you will receive more specific information about the schedule for this work and how it affects your driveway access.

HOW WILL MY WATER SERVICE BE AFFECTED?

There are currently no planned disruptions for water service, as this project does not include service transfer. However, should work on-site impact water service, you will be notified, along with instructions to follow after the connection is made.
