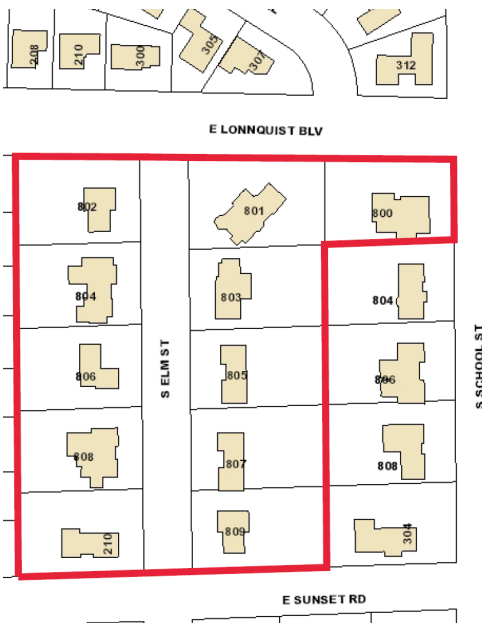


INTRODUCTION

The Village of Mount Prospect is preparing to start construction on the final phase of the Prospect Meadows Drainage Improvements as well as ditch work along sections of Elm Street and Glendale Lane. The project will create a more effective roadway drainage system and eliminate areas of standing water in ditches. To do so, sections of the parkway ditch adjacent to your property will be regraded by a contractor to be hired by the Village. The map below shows the properties affected by the project.

In general, the project will include removal of most existing driveway culverts and installation of new driveway culvert pipe. The roadway ditches affected by construction activities will be regraded and restored with topsoil and grass. Driveway aprons that had culverts replaced will be restored in-kind with concrete or asphalt pavement. The project will also include installation of tree protection fencing and tree trimming in spot locations.

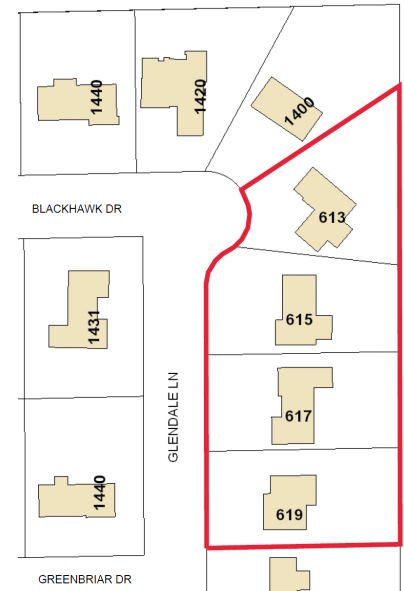
Elm St / Lonquist Blvd

CONSTRUCTION IMPACT

There will be no activity that will require the road to be closed during construction. There will be no changes in your regular services such as garbage pick-up, mail delivery, or emergency services from the Police and Fire Departments. However, access to your driveway will be interrupted should there be a need to replace your culvert. We will make these interruptions as short as possible and give you advanced notice to move your vehicles to the street. Should there be a need to park on the street overnight, the Police Department will be notified to relax the parking ordinance. Mailboxes are not being replaced and we will try to maintain access to them throughout the project.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The Village anticipates starting construction late April or early May. Visit the project web page to see when work along your street will begin. As is typical with this sort of work, the weather will be a key factor in determining the start and length of the project. It is anticipated that all the work will be completed by the end of September.

Late April / Early May: Construction is to begin.

Late April – Mid September: Removal of existing driveway culverts and installation of new driveway culvert pipe; roadway ditches regraded and restored (topsoil and grass); driveway aprons restored with concrete or asphalt.

Late September: Final inspection and completion of project.

QUESTIONS DURING CONSTRUCTION?

If you have a brick driveway, sprinkler system, decorative landscaping, invisible dog fence, etc., within or near the ditch please notify the Public Works Department prior to construction. We are available to meet on-site to discuss any potential impacts in front of your property. Per Village ordinance, it is your responsibility to temporarily relocate, reinstall, or repair any of these items during construction as necessary.
