Mount Prospect Village Board to Host Committee of the Whole Meeting "on the Road"

The Mount Prospect Village Board is taking its June 11 Committee of the Whole (COW) meeting "on the road." This neighborhood "COW on the Road" will be hosted at RecPlex (420 Dempster St.) from 6-7:30 p.m. where the Mayor, Trustees, and Village staff will discuss Village services, economic development, and planned infrastructure projects in south Mount Prospect. Members of the public are invited to listen, engage, and ask questions.

The meeting will feature presentations on the following topics: Fire Station 11 progress, enhanced EMS/fire services for south Mount Prospect and unincorporated areas, annexation of southern unincorporated properties, overview of South Mount Prospect TIF, Connect South Mount Prospect Plan, Algonquin Rd. Shared Use Path, Oakton St. water main, Human Services needs assessment, and more.

About Neighborhood "COW on the Road" Meetings

Taking COW meetings "on the road" allows the Village Board to highlight a different location, project, or area in Mount Prospect while also giving residents a chance to attend a meeting closer to home. Established by Mayor Paul Wm. Hoefert, "COW on the Road" meetings are intended to engage the community within their respective neighborhoods. The Village Board plans to hold a COW meeting "on the road" quarterly.

"My goal is to bring government to the people," said Mayor Hoefert. "I understand that residents and the business community cannot always attend our meetings at Village Hall, so I want to make the process more accessible by meeting people where they are."
