## <u>PRESS RELEASE</u> MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE DEPARTMENT ARRESTS OFFENDER IN RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

On Friday, October 20, 2017, the Mount Prospect Police Department arrested and charged Matthew Cadwell, 30 years old, of 209 Washington Avenue #1A, Elk Grove Village with one count of Residential Burglary.

On September 8, 2017, the Mount Prospect Police Department responded to the 800 block of South We Go Trail for a report of a residential burglary. Upon arrival, officers located a broken window on an exterior door to the basement of the house. Officers discovered a landscaping rock on the basement floor, which appeared to be used to break the window. The house was ransacked and United States Currency was taken in the burglary. An Evidence Technician from the Mount Prospect Police Department responded to the home and processed the crime scene for evidence. A palm print was located in the house that did not belong to the residents of the house. The palm print was analyzed and verified as a match belonging to Matthew Cadwell. Mount Prospect Police Investigators were able to locate Cadwell, at which point he was arrested and charged with residential burglary.

Cadwell was taken to a Cook County Courthouse for a bond hearing where his bond was set at \$80,000.00 "D". His next court appearance is scheduled for November 9, 2017 at 10:30 AM in room 108 of the Cook County 3<sup>rd</sup> District Courthouse in Rolling Meadows.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
