## <u>PRESS RELEASE</u> MOUNT PROSPECT POLICE DEPARTMENT ARRESTS OFFENDER IN RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY



**Rengay Frazier** 

On Thursday, December 13, 2017, the Mount Prospect Police Department charged Rengay Frazier, 46 years old, of 7821 Crawford Avenue, Skokie, with one count of Residential Burglary.

On October 17, 2017 at approximately 8:48 PM, the Mount Prospect Police Department responded to the 700 block of Windsor Drive for a report of a residential burglary. Upon arrival, officers observed that the rear door of the residence had been forcibly opened. After a subsequent search of the home's interior, it was learned that jewelry had been taken from the home. The home's front door had a video doorbell installed that captured a video of the offender approaching the front door of the house at approximately 7:30 PM. The image of the offender was shared with other law enforcement agencies and Rengay Frazier was identified by multiple police agencies as the offender seen in the video.

Frazier was charged with one count of residential burglary on December 13, 2017. He was taken to a bond hearing on December 13 at the Cook County 3<sup>rd</sup> District Courthouse in Rolling Meadows, where his bond was set at \$200,000.00 "D". His next court appearance is scheduled for January 5, 2018 at 10:30 AM in room 108 of the Cook County 3<sup>rd</sup> District Courthouse in Rolling Meadows.

Residents are reminded to report all suspicious activity immediately by calling 9-1-1.

The public is reminded that criminal charges are not evidence of guilt and that all defendants in a criminal case are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
